

National Mobilization To Stop Trump War on North Korea

November 6 – 11, 2017

Teach-ins, Legislative Visits, and Protests

The United States and North Korea are on a dangerous path towards a military confrontation that would kill millions and engulf the world in a nuclear holocaust. It's time for the U.S. anti-war and peace movements to mobilize mass opposition to Trump's saber rattling and demand a diplomatic solution to the crisis with North Korea.

Trump has threatened, "to totally destroy North Korea," and to "unleash fire and fury like the world has never seen." Since the U.S. has declared war on it, North Korea says it has the right to shoot down U.S. strategic bombers not even within their airspace in self-defense. In both Washington and Pyongyang, hardliners are calling the shots.

The war of words has moved to provocative military action. The US has transferred strategic assets to South Korea, and the nuclear aircraft carrier USS George Washington is barreling towards the Korean Peninsula. North Korea has threatened to test an atmospheric nuclear weapon and test fire a missile capable of reaching the West Coast.

The last time the US was this close to going to war with North Korea was when President Clinton considered a pre-emptive strike on its nuclear reactors. [Secretary of Defense William Perry](#) who weighed the 1994 pre-emptive strike says, "Americans should understand vividly that we are on the brink of war with a regime in North Korea that—unlike in 1994—already possesses a nuclear arsenal of perhaps 20 weapons."

Join a coalition of grassroots and national peace organizations for a nationwide mobilization November 6-11 calling for peace and diplomacy to resolve the standoff with North Korea. Ahead of Trump's visit to Asia where massive protests are being planned in South Korea and Japan, we will host a series of online teach-ins to bring the peace movement up to speed on the historic roots of the Korean conflict and what we must do now to avert war with North Korea.
